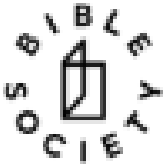
The Food Bank will be open on

## Bible Course



As a benefice, we are running the Bible Society's newly updated Bible Course.

The 8-week course explores God's big story by taking participants through the whole narrative of the Bible, from Genesis to Revelation. It helps us to get to grips with the Bible's key themes and confidently apply Scripture to everyday life. Each week will contain high quality videos, discussion questions and Bible study.

Handbooks will be provided, and there is a digital hub and daily readings to engage further with the material. The course runs at 7:30 pm on Wednesday evenings, from 29<sup>th</sup> April to 24<sup>th</sup> June (with a break for half term) in the Barnabas Centre, St Paul's.

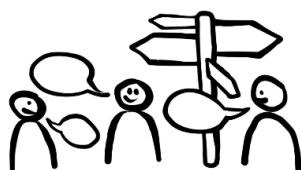
