Parents Please Note Junior Church Drop-off and Collection.

Collection will happen during the *Agnus Dei* (when the servers form a semi-circle at the front), so that you can receive the Holy Eucharist or a blessing together as a family, and release the Junior Church team to rejoin theirs.

Electoral Roll

The Church Electoral Roll is a list of those who regularly worship at St. Edward's Church. It is the foundation of the whole structure of synodical government of the Church of England. On a practical level, it enables the parish to keep in touch with church members and forms a basis for wider pastoral contacts. If you are on the Church Electoral Roll you can stand for election onto the PCC and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting which this year will take place on Sunday 24th May 2026 at 11.30am. Anyone who worships regularly at St. Edward's Church - whether on Sundays or during the week - is warmly encouraged to join. To join the Church Electoral Roll you must be at least 16 years of age and baptised (and have worshipped regularly for at least 6 months if you don't live in the parish). Electoral Roll forms are available at the back of church. Once completed, please hand in for the attention of the Electoral Roll Officer. Please note that the Church Electoral Roll was renewed last year, so most members of our congregation will already be included, but if you are a more recent member of our congregation and have not done so, then please do consider entering your name to the Church Electoral Roll.
