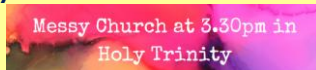

PREPARING FOR OUR ANNUAL CHURCH MEETING

On Sunday 10th May we will be holding our Annual Parochial Church Meeting which is part of the governance system of the Church of England. This will be held after the 9:30am service where we have an opportunity to reflect on events of the past year, to celebrate our life together in our church community and to elect members of the congregation to take part in our church council and to other roles. Everyone is welcome - indeed encouraged - to attend but every church has to maintain a formal register called the Electoral Roll of the people who are able to participate in any matters requiring a vote.

This electoral roll is reviewed every year and over the next month or so we will be asking members of the congregation who are not already on the Electoral Roll to consider whether they wish their names to be added. You can, of course, be a full and active member of Holy Trinity without joining the Roll and being on the Electoral Roll does not entail signing up to any additional commitments. Simply regarding Holy Trinity Church as your spiritual home is enough to be a part of this community. However the number of members joining the Electoral Roll does also help the Church show its strength and determines how representation on the governing bodies of the church is determined. To apply for the Electoral Roll you must meet ALL the following conditions:

You must be aged 16 or over (though you can apply in the year you become 16 and your name will be entered once your birth date has passed). You must be baptised. You must EITHER live in the parish OR have attended Holy Trinity regularly for at least 6 months or have been a 'habitual member' of our church family. Application forms for the new Electoral Roll will be available in church until Sunday 25th April. There will also be forms available for nominations to the Roles of Churchwarden, Deanery Synod members and members of our church council (The 'PCC')

If you have any questions please talk to the clergy, church wardens or Robert Eden who is responsible for preparing the Roll for Holy Trinity. You can be on the Electoral Roll of more than one Church, but you can only serve on the PCC of one Church at a time.
