Absence dates

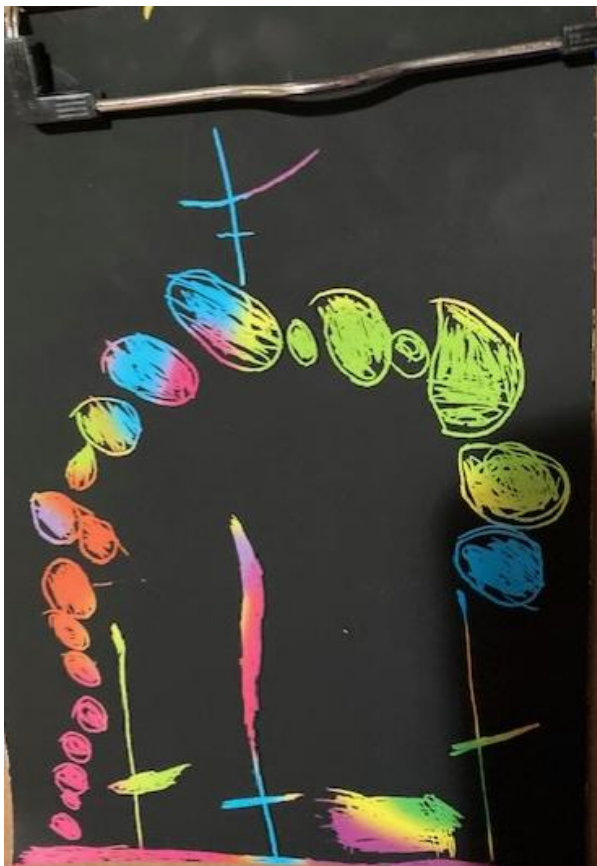

Notice for Camborne & Tuckingmill APCM

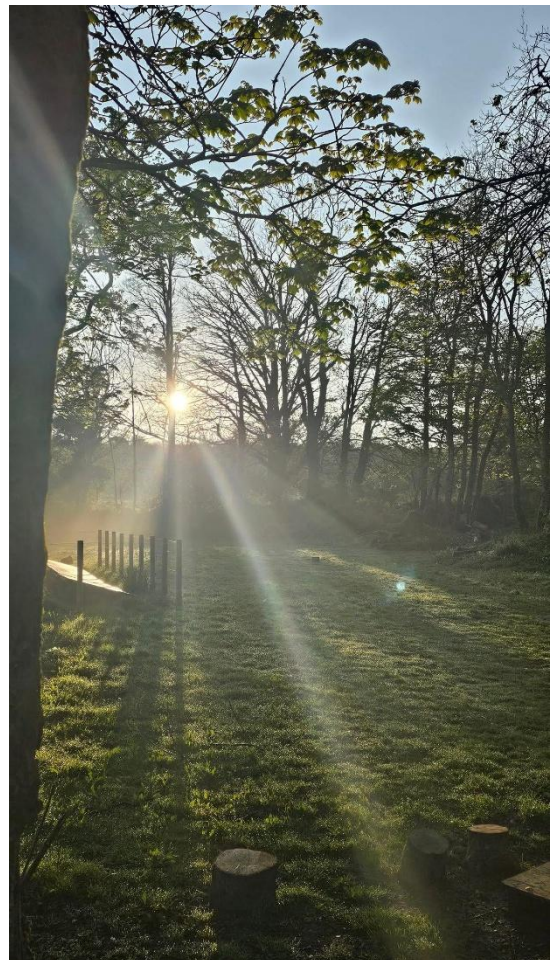
