## Cornish Language Eucharist

As some of you know, Mike O'Connor has written a music setting for the Eucharist in Cornish. It's a people's setting, easy to sing for ordinary people, rather than for a cathedral choir only. It uses Cornish folk tunes, which we can all sing. I think it's very beautiful.

The setting, named 'Mass of the Resurrection', will be launched in Truro Cathedral on St Petroc's Eve, Wednesday the 3rd of June at 5.30 pm. I am hoping to hold a rehearsal of the music with Mike before the service, so we will all be able to sing together. The Cathedral Choir will lead the singing.

It's a very important occasion, both for the church in Cornwall and the language itself. I believe that this is the first music setting for the Eucharist written in Cornish, so that the whole service may be conducted in Cornish.

So, put it in your diaries and join us if you can. It will be a very special occasion.
