Celebrating Ascension and Pentecost

This May, our Church communities will be reflecting on the events following Easter, focusing on the Ascension of Jesus. His return back to Heaven and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. These moments remind us of the promises Jesus made to His followers and how those promises continue to bring comfort and guidance to us today.

Pentecost this year falls on Sunday 24th May, 50 days after Easter Day. It was originally known as Whit Sunday or Whitsun. It used to be marked by Whit walks or parades and often featured brass bands, particularly in the northwest.
