THE ROAD TO EMMAUS : One of the loveliest stories in the Gospel is the story of how the risen Jesus joined two of his disciples on the road to Emmaus. He explained the scriptures to them, and revealed himself in the breaking of the bread. The same thing happens for us when we celebrate the Eucharist. Jesus speaks to us in the scriptures and nourishes us in Communion. Lord Jesus, you are our companion on our journey of faith, you speak to us when the Scriptures are read and you nourish us with the bread of the Eucharist.

REFLECTION : Jesus : life's companion

All through life's day, you walk with us Lord. But often we don't recognise you, for we are blinded by work and worry, doubt, confusion and fear, and so you remain a stranger to us. Before the day's end we will ask many questions, experience many sorrows and disappointments. And then, suddenly, whether we are young, middle-aged, or old, we will find that night is approaching. In that moment we pray, that, like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, our eyes will be opened, and that we will recognise you. And you will not vanish from our sight, but stay with us to guide us to the Father's house.

REFLECTION 2 : How to recognise the Lord

If you wish to have life, do what the disciples did. They offered him hospitality. The Lord looked set on continuing his journey but they detained him. At the end of their journey they said to him: 'Stay with us, for the day is spent.' The Lord revealed himself in the breaking of bread. Hospitality restored to them what lack of faith had taken away. So, if you wish to recognise the Saviour, Take in the stranger. Seek the Lord in the sharing of bread.
