Sunday Worship at St Michael's

8am Service

Sowing – Growing – Going

Children & Families at St Michael's



Children and families are at the core of our ministry at St Michael's. In 2025, After a five-year absence, we introduced Sunday morning worship for children using **Godly Play**. Through creative story-telling and a range of activities, children grow in faith for themselves, where the emphasis is on *knowing God*, not *just knowing about God*. We work closely with an Ignite who provide groups for older children and teenagers locally. We sow seeds of God's love in young hearts through our midweek **Toddlly Play** worship, and in our monthly **Messy Church**. We are active in our local schools at Swarland and Felton through **Open the Book** and **Collective Worship**. And we go out so share these ministries in other parishes too.



How to find us

St Michael's is on a hill on the south-east side of the village on Church Bank, which is just off the road to Longframlington. We encourage people to park in the village and walk up to the church as parking is very limited, and we want to keep the spaces available for worshippers with mobility requirements.
