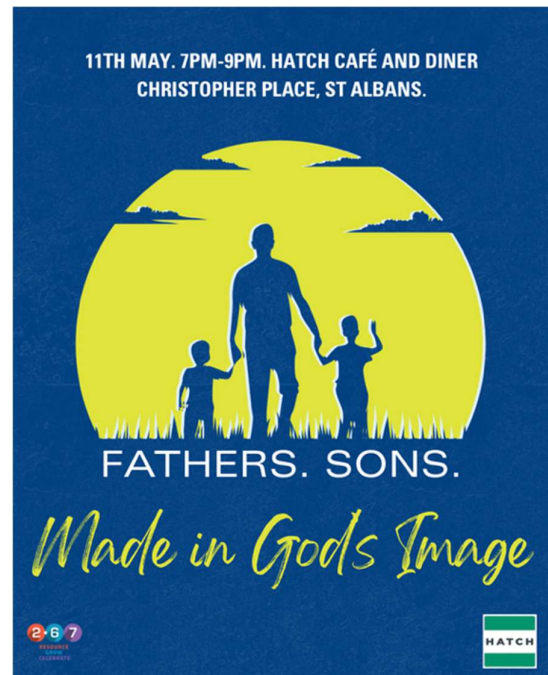
There are a number of vacancies which need filling, please carefully consider if God might be calling you or someone you know to these important roles in our church life:
