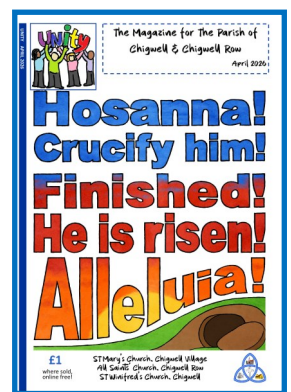
There is no **Time 2 Destress** on Wednesday; next week there's 'Rest & Refresh'.
