**A reading from the second letter of Paul to the Corinthians.**

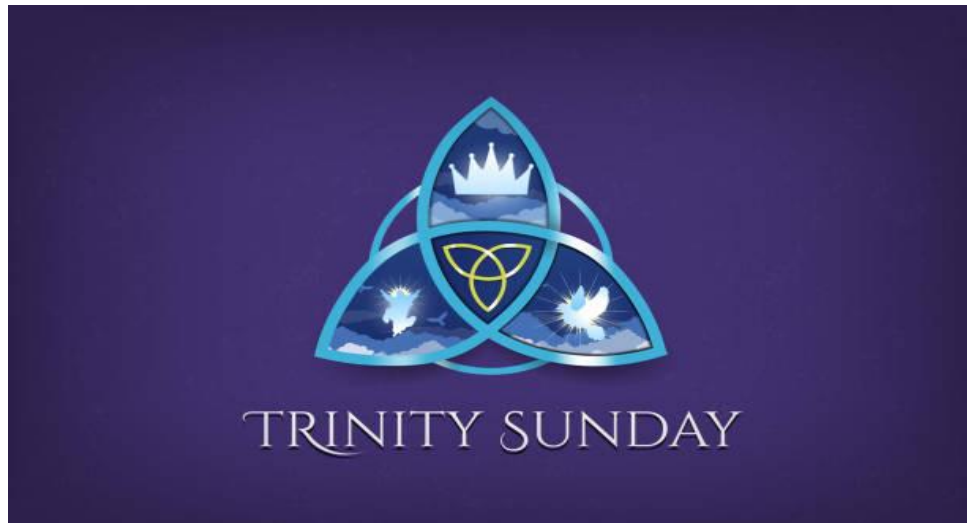
