### Pentecost Vigil

7.30pm, Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May, in Church

Continuing last year's revival of what - from the Early Church through to the 1950s - was formerly the 2<sup>nd</sup> biggest celebration of the year (after the Easter Vigil), the Pentecost Vigil is essentially a shortened version of the Easter Vigil upon which it is based, and includes Vigil readings, the Blessing of the Font, Litany of the Saints, & 1<sup>st</sup> Mass of Pentecost. With traditional liturgy derived from the pre-1955 rites of the Western Church.
