When is your ordination? Can we attend?

Yes—please do come if you can! I'd love to see some familiar faces there. I'll be ordained deacon at 4pm on Saturday 27th June at Lichfield Cathedral. It's usually quite a full service, so it's worth getting there about 30 minutes early.

What will your role look like week by week?

My curacy is part-time (0.6), so I won't be around all the time, but you'll still see me regularly. On Sundays, I'll usually be at two of our three congregations (it will vary a bit week to week). During the week, I'll be working two main days (initially Mondays and Wednesdays) alongside some ongoing study. And genuinely, do ask me what I've been reading... I'll probably be keen to tell you!



Who is overseeing your training, and will we see them in our churches?

My Training Incumbent is the Revd Ian Cardinal, who'll be guiding me through these next few years. You will see him from time to time, especially when I'm leading or preaching. He normally worships at the cathedral, so he won't be with us every week, but when he is, do say hello.

What are you doing before your ordination?

I've just finished my role at the Hothouse in Aldridge, and I'm staying on placement at Aldridge Parish Church until the end of the month while I finish my MA dissertation. I've handed in a first draft (which felt like a milestone!), but there's still more to do—so prayers definitely appreciated.

What are you looking forward to most of all?

Honestly, getting to know people better. I know a few of you already, but I'm really looking forward to being more fully part of the life of the churches—worshipping together, learning together, and just sharing everyday life. It'll be really special to minister in the place where I live, and I'm excited to see what God has in store for us.
