A word for the week

Families pass on more than just a possible inheritance of material riches, more important, they pass on the sure inheritance of a way of viewing and dealing with life - a family spirit. Sometimes this spirit is life-giving, sometimes it is unhealthy, sometimes this spirit is lived, and sometimes it is rejected.

Jesus promises us: I will leave you but not abandon you, I will live always in you, I will continue to show myself to you, the Father and I will send you our Spirit of truth to guide and nurture you. The Spirit Jesus passes on to us is always life-giving. We are faced daily with this life-giving choice: to live in the Spirit or reject this way of living. In the Spirit, we are to live as Jesus lived, following his commandments: forgiving one another, healing one another, nourishing one another, offering a second coat, walking the extra mile, loving our enemies, washing one another's feet, laying down our life for the sake of the other. As difficult as living this way sometimes is, we are empowered to do so because of Jesus' continued love.
