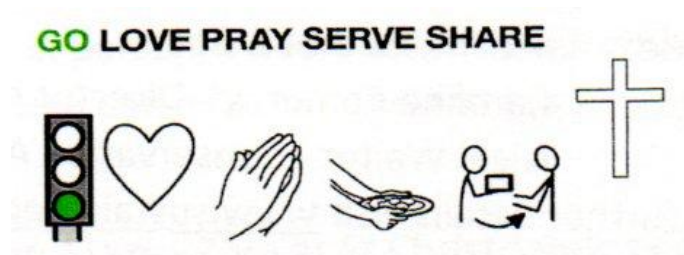
Persecuted Church: Libya
