Since the very beginning of the Church, these nine days between Ascension and Pentecost –called the Novena– have been a time of prayer. Not just praying as individuals, but as a community, like those very first Christians.

To aid us in our prayers there is a free booklet called 'God with Us' by Archbishop Sarah, which will be left at the back of each church for you to pick up. She is encouraging each of us to pray for 5 people, that they may come to follow Christ and know how much God loves them. Imagine if we each brought 5 new people along to church as a result!!

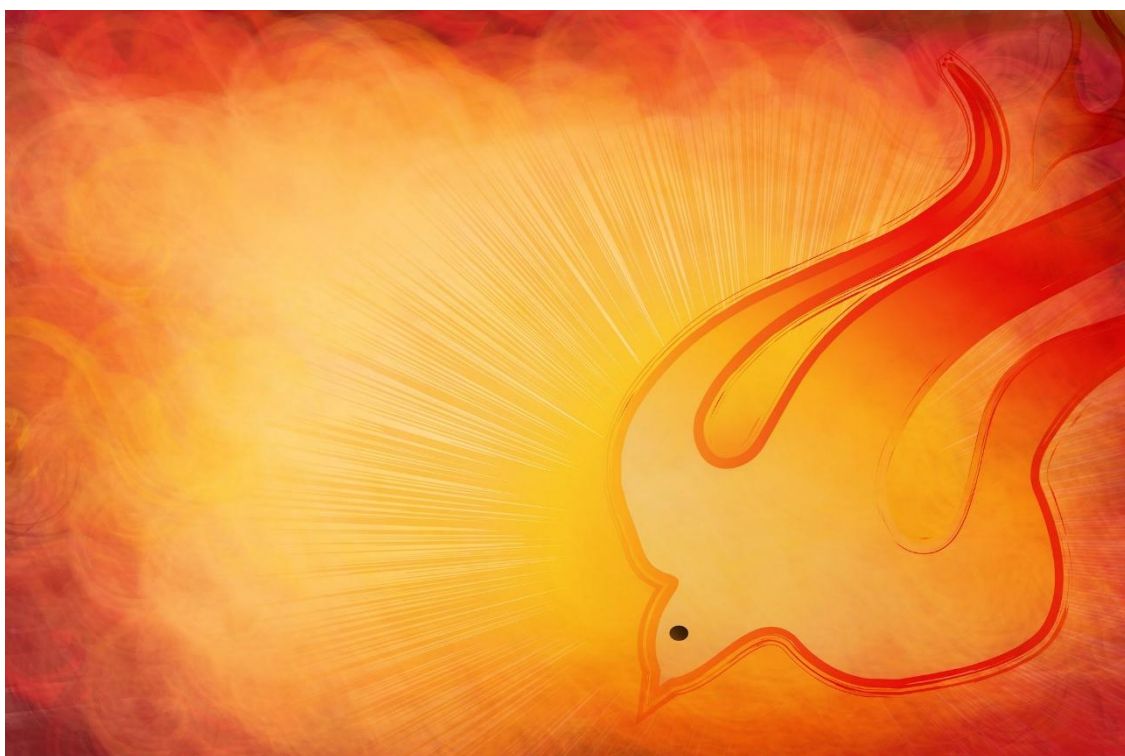
