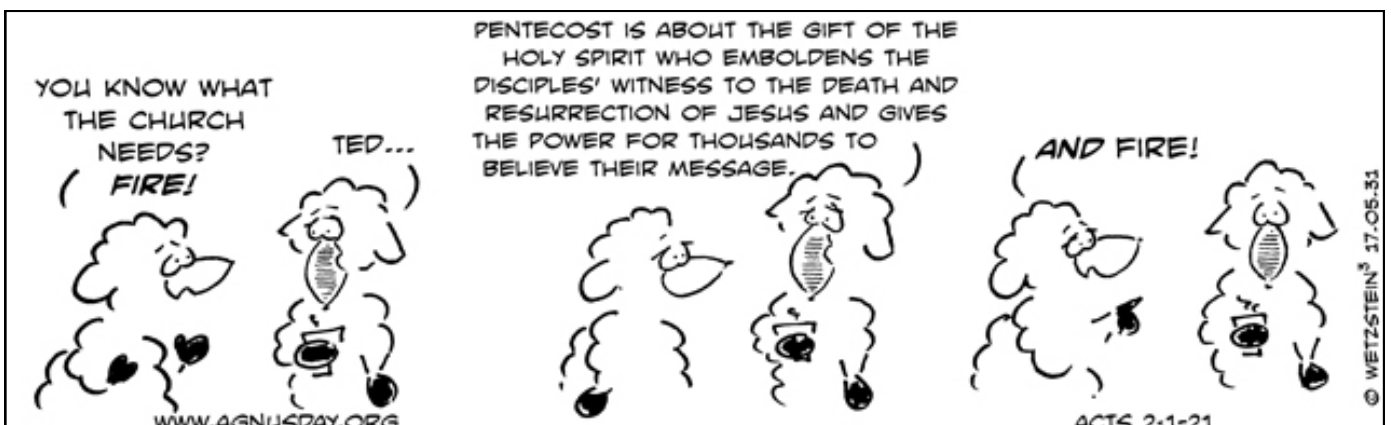
 On Tuesday, it's **Time 4 God**, 2:00pm at All Saints' House, and later **St Win's DCC** meets, 7:30pm on Zoom.

- ♦ *St Winifred's:* please remember Andy in your prayers. We also pray for any other members of the church community who are unwell or struggling.

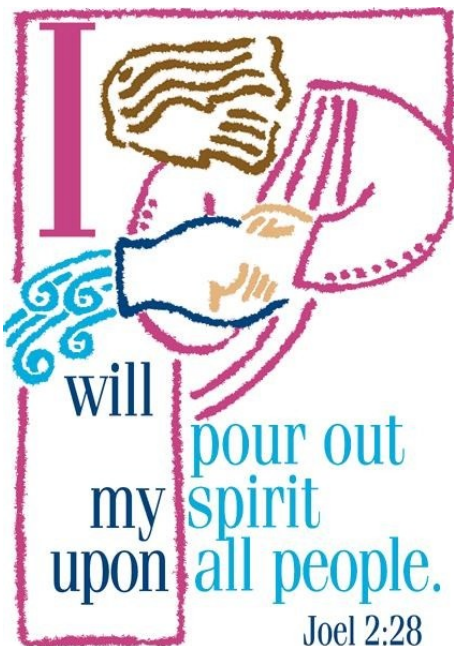
