• **AMP** - open to anyone who lives in the church parish of Hellingly and Upper Dicker. Here Churchwardens are elected. Churchwardens stand down every year and have to be re-elected annually. Anyone on the Electoral Roll of our church may be nominated. Please get a nomination form from Carol, our PCC Secretary, if you are interested.

• **APCM** - This meeting is open to all who are on the church's electoral roll. See Fin, our ER officer, if you would like to join. This meeting audits the proceedings and business of the PCC (Parochial Church Council) and elects members onto it. Reports are heard from the Vicar and other reports of finance and fabric concern. Reports from Deanery Synod are heard too. Sidespersons are appointed as required as well as an auditor. Matters from the floor can be raised for the PCC to consider.
