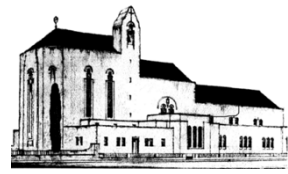


THE PARISH CHURCH OF SAINT COLUMBA, ANFIELD
