1st READING: Deuteronomy 6: 4-9

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God,
the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your
God with all your heart, and with all your
soul, and with all your might. Keep these
words that I am commanding you today in
your heart. Recite them to your children and
talk about them when you are at home and
when you are away, when you lie down and
when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your
hand, fix them as an emblem on your
forehead, and write them on the doorposts of
your house and on your gates.

2ND READING: 1 John 3: 1-7

See what love the Father has given us, that
we should be called children of God; and that
is what we are. The reason the world does
not know us is that it did not know
him. Beloved, we are God's children now;
what we will be has not yet been revealed.
What we do know is this: when he is
revealed, we will be like him, for we will see
him as he is. And all who have this hope in
him purify themselves, just as he is pure.
Everyone who commits sin is guilty of
lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. You know
that he was revealed to take away sins, and
in him there is no sin. No one who abides in
him sins; no one who sins has either seen
him or known him. Little children, let no one
deceive you. Everyone who does what is
right is righteous, just as he is righteous.

GOSPEL: John 17: 1-11

After Jesus had spoken these words, he
looked up to heaven and said, 'Father, the
hour has come; glorify your Son so that the
Son may glorify you, since you have given
him authority over all people, to give eternal
life to all whom you have given him. And
this is eternal life, that they may know you,
the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom
you have sent. I glorified you on earth by
finishing the work that you gave me to
do. So now, Father, glorify me in your own
presence with the glory that I had in your
presence before the world existed.
'I have made your name known to those
whom you gave me from the world. They
were yours, and you gave them to me, and
they have kept your word. Now they know
that everything you have given me is from
you; for the words that you gave to me I
have given to them, and they have received
them and know in truth that I came from
you; and they have believed that you sent
me. I am asking on their behalf; I am not
asking on behalf of the world, but on behalf
of those whom you gave me, because they
are yours. All mine are yours, and yours are
mine; and I have been glorified in
them. And now I am no longer in the world,
but they are in the world, and I am coming
to you. Holy Father, protect them in your
name that you have given me, so that they
may be one, as we are one.
