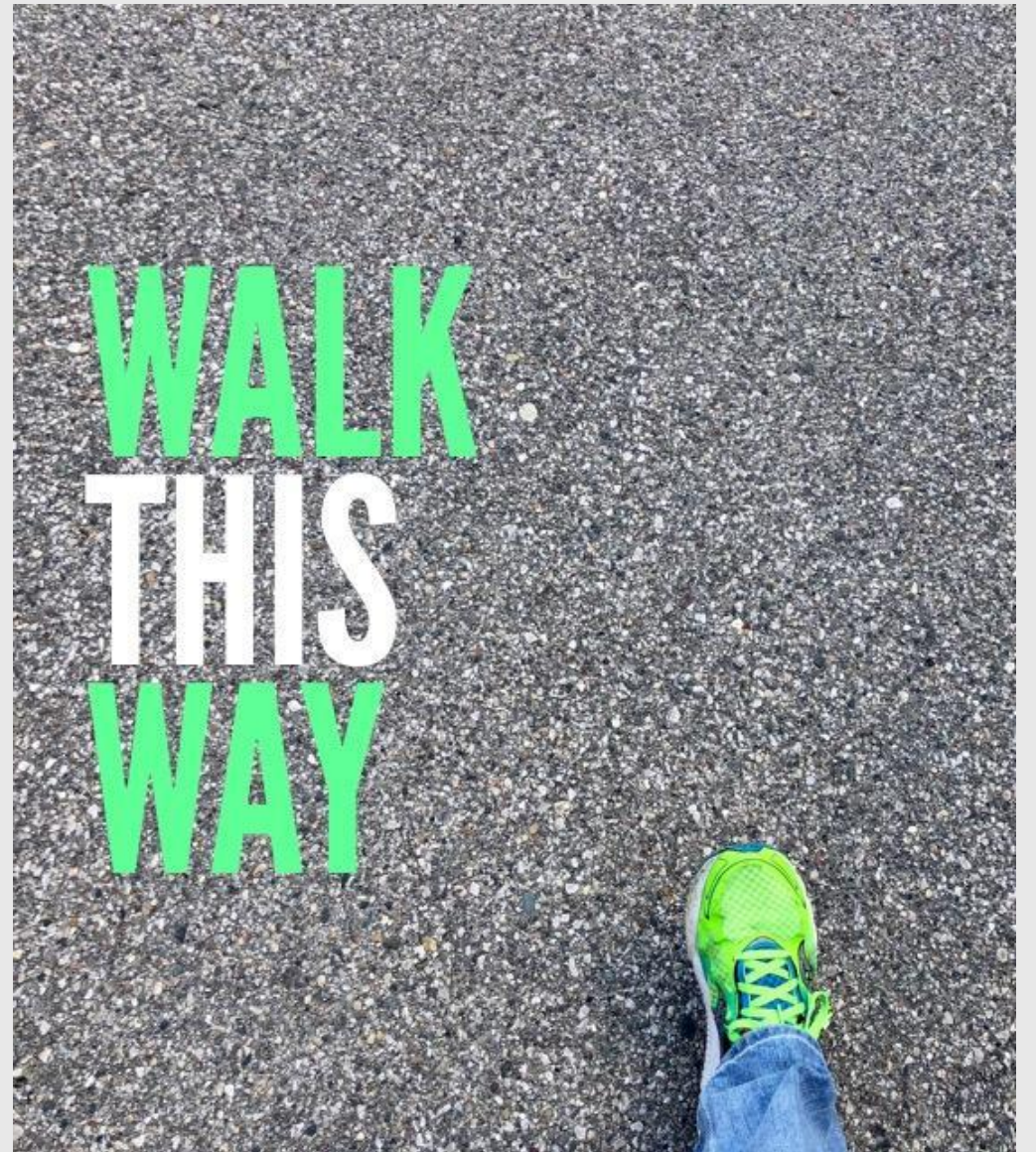

the choice to live the way he wants us to.



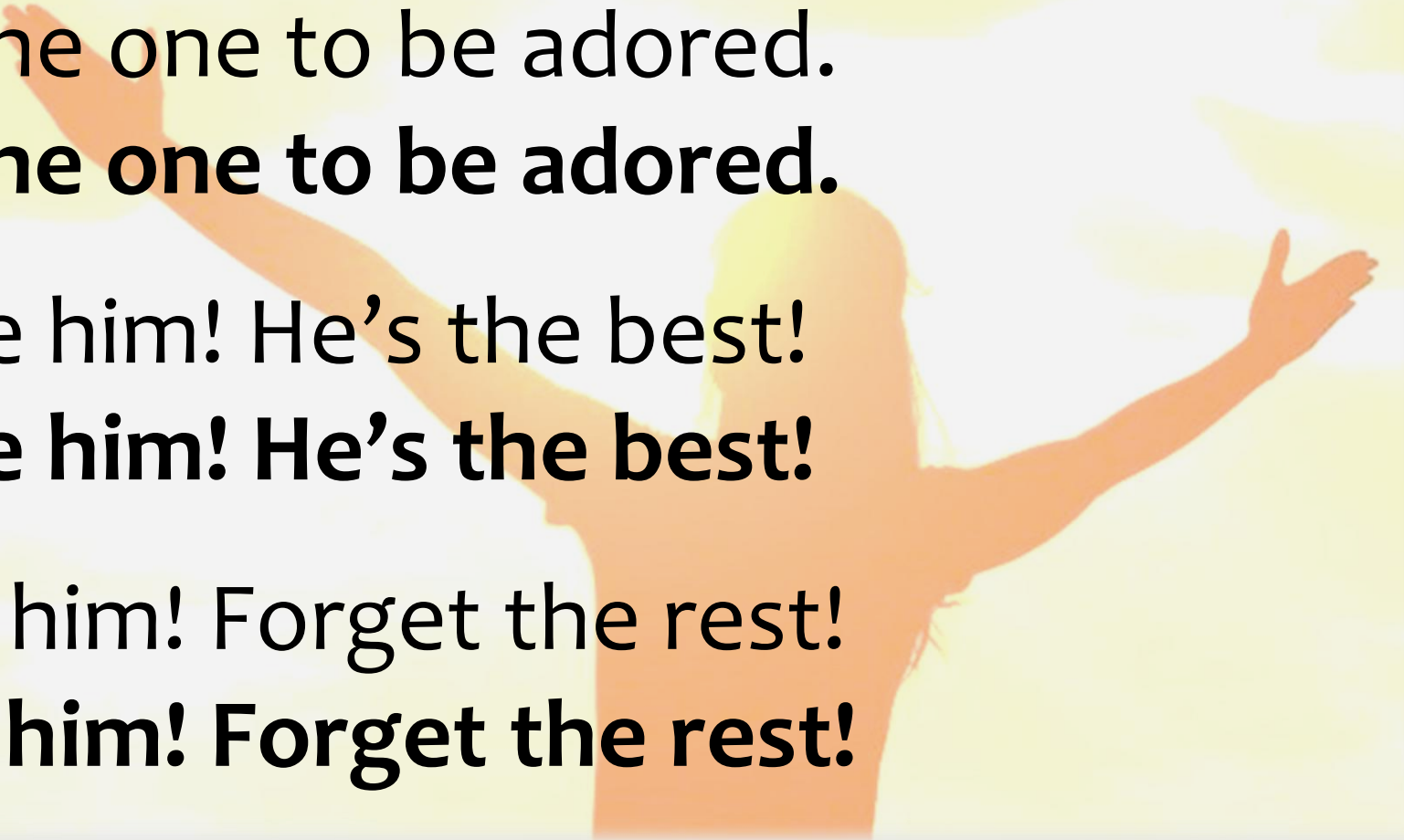

**Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy.**

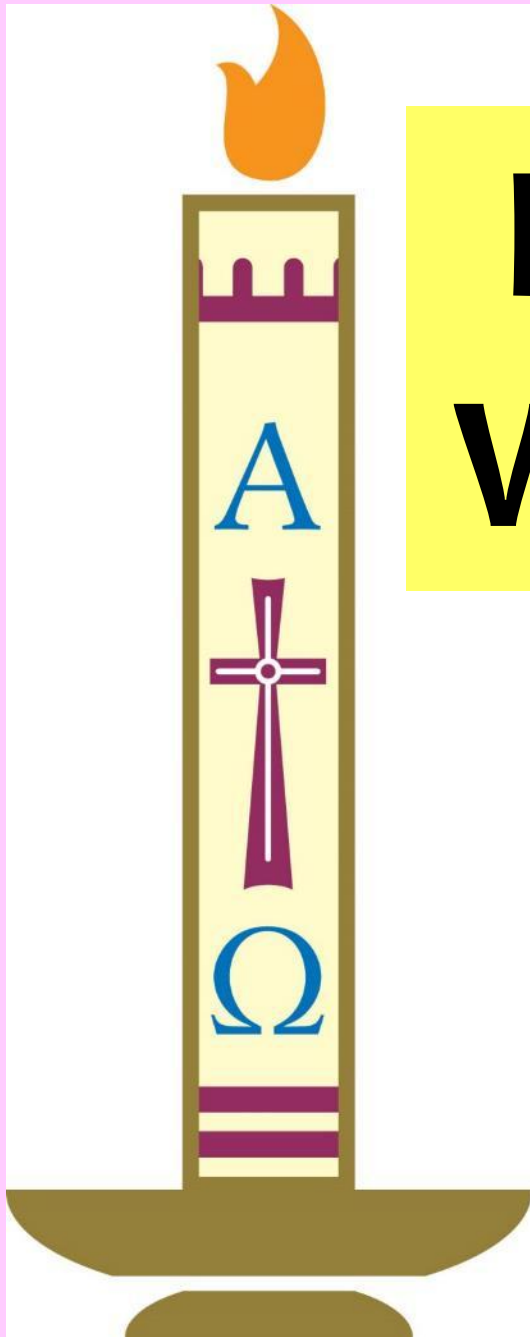
Saying Sorry

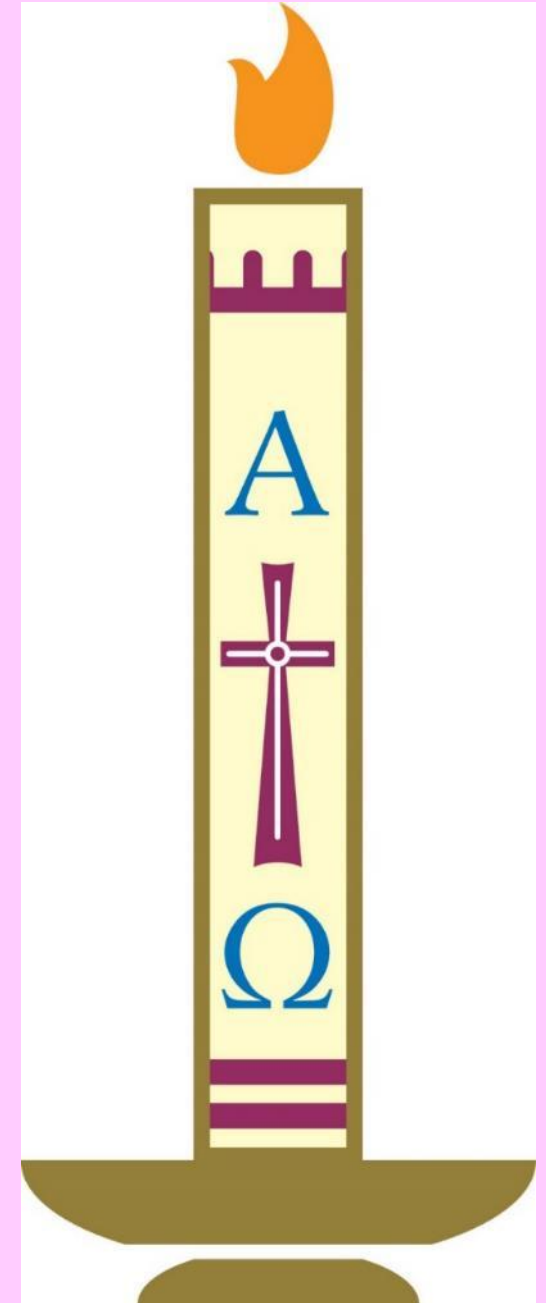
# Baptism Welcome

We welcome you.**

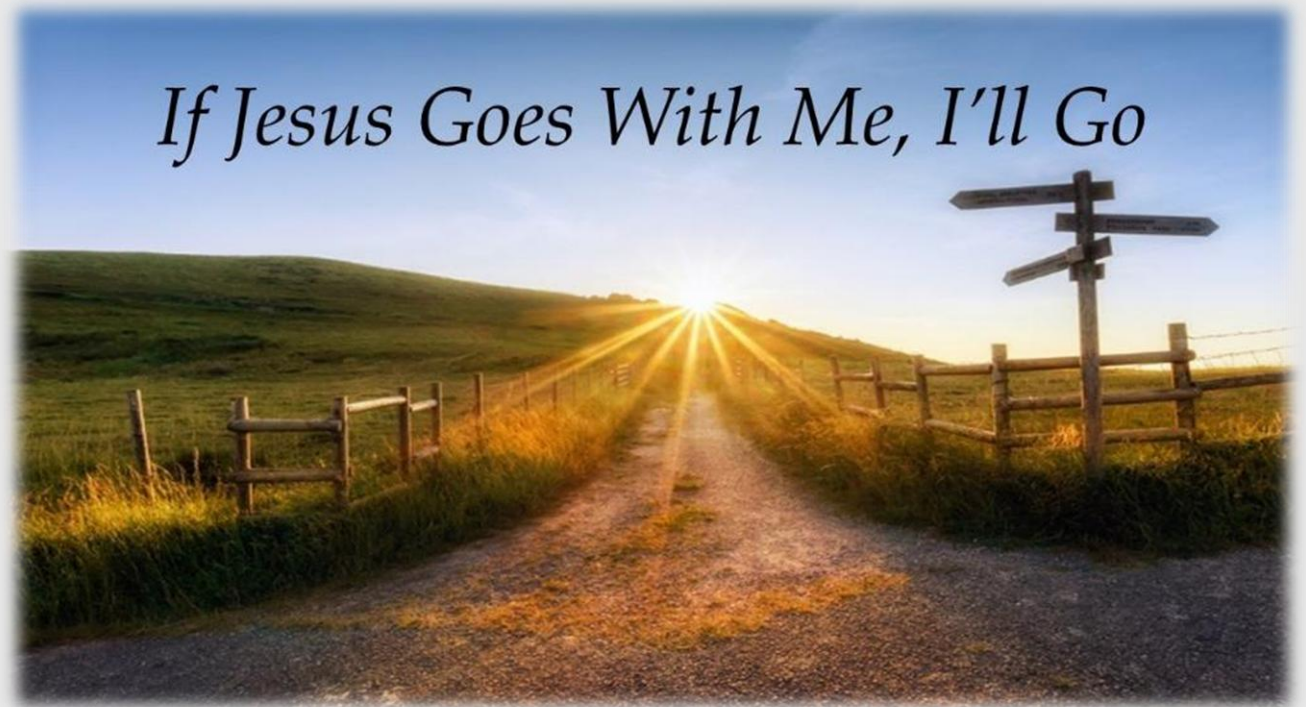

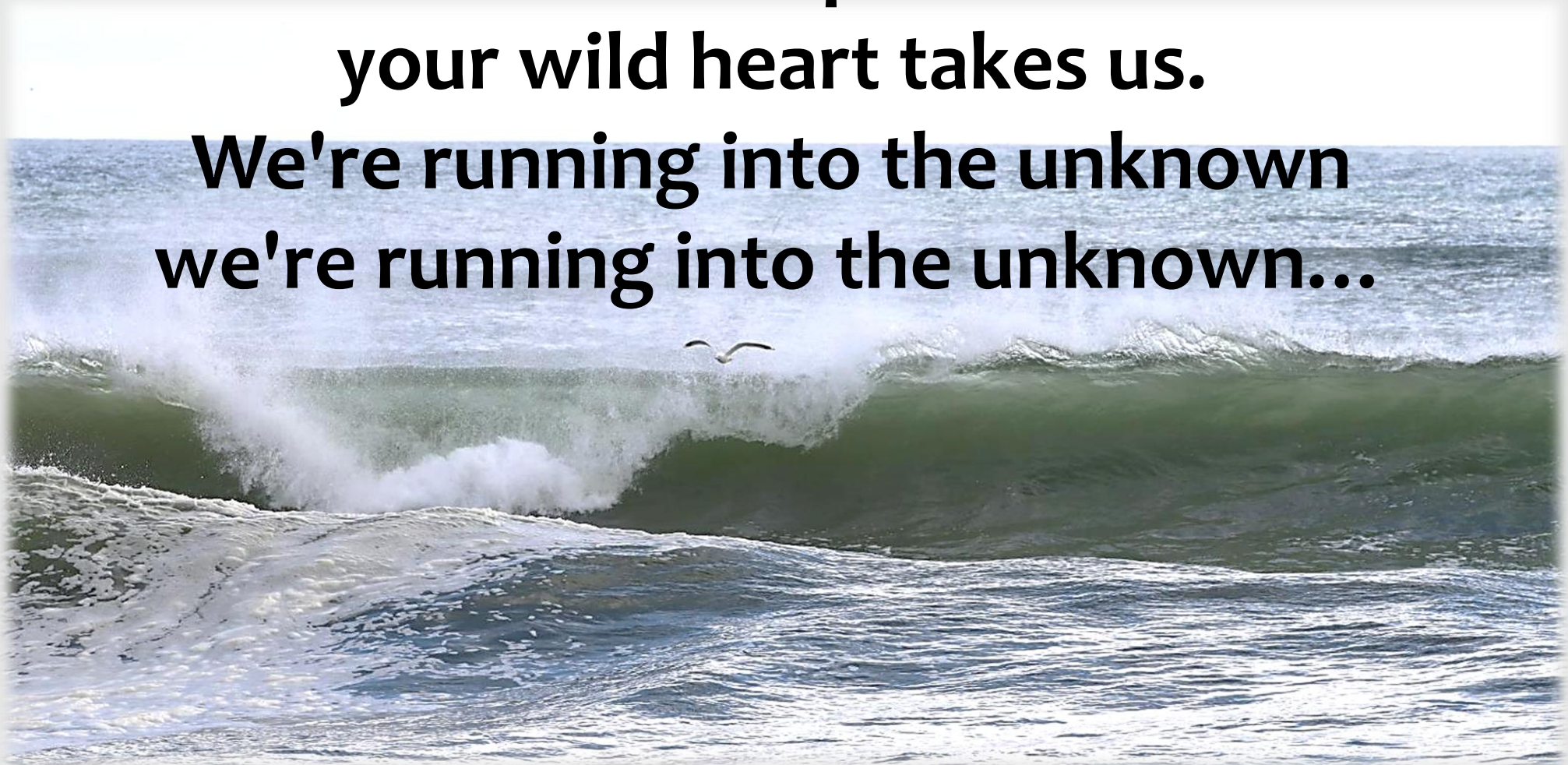

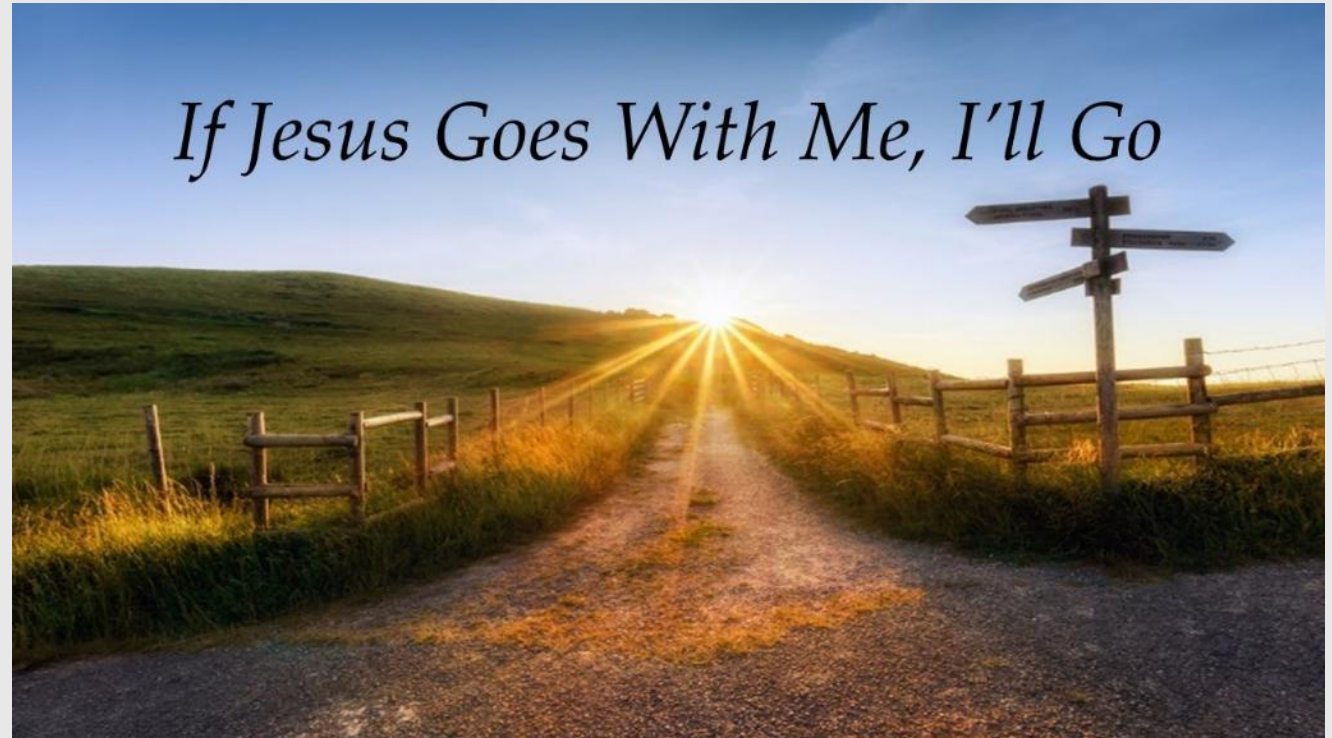

## The choice game for everyone

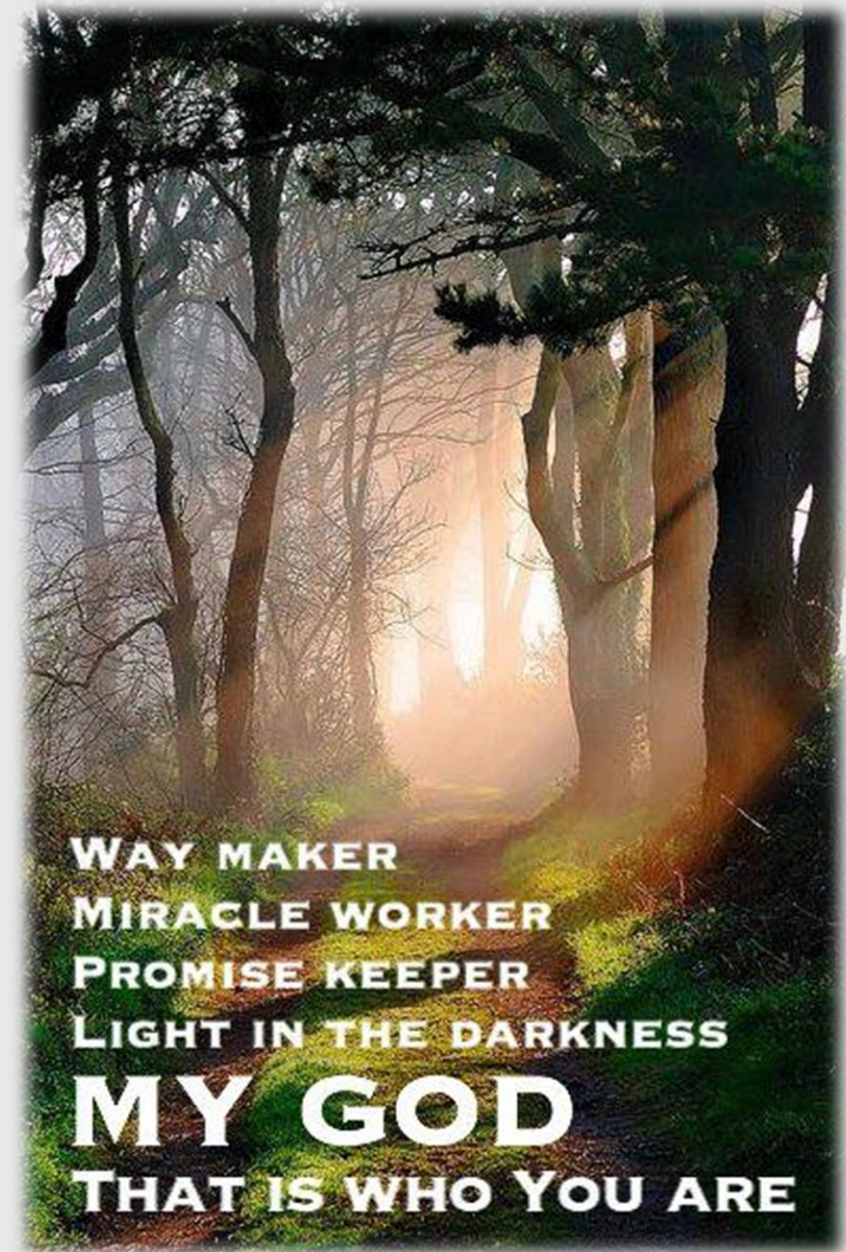
