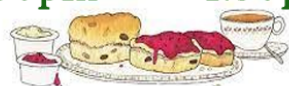

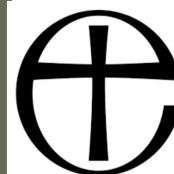

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul is celebrated by Christians worldwide on Monday June 29, commemorating the martyrdom of these two pivotal apostles.



Saint Peter, or Simon Peter, is often depicted holding 2 keys—one gold and one silver. This goes back to the Gospel of Matthew, where Jesus tells Peter, "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on

earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matthew 16:19). Saint Peter was the first Bishop of Rome and a founder of the early Christian Church.

Saint Paul, or Saul, was a tent maker and a Pharisee who persecuted Christians until he had a conversion on the road to Damascus. Although he never met Jesus he was a skilled orator and a pivotal influence on the early Christian Church with his preaching and letters.



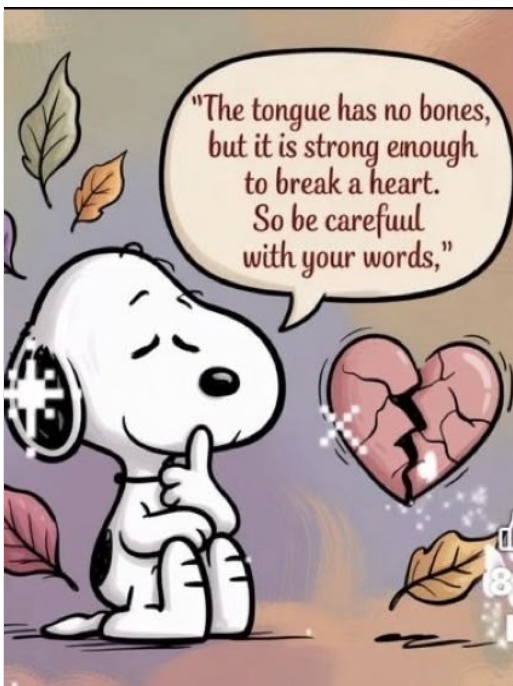
