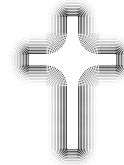

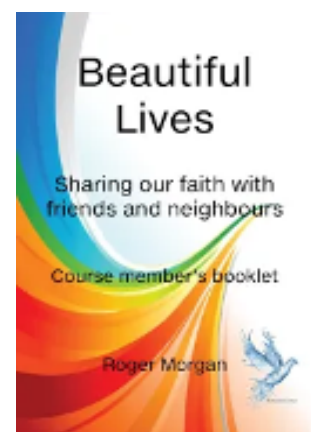
Beautiful Lives 2026
