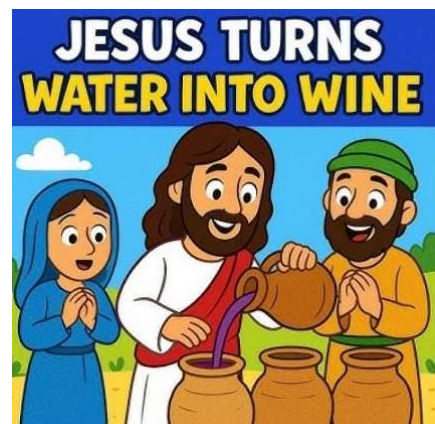
It promises to be a great day for all the family, and we look forward to seeing many of you there.
