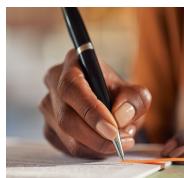

Only seven weeks to go! Frinton Mission 2026 will start on Sunday 26th July with an opening service at the marquee on the Greensward at 5pm. An evangelistic summer mission has been held in Frinton for over one hundred years, with local churches (now CCT, previously FACT) taking over from Scripture Union and CSSM in 1993. Christian volunteers from local churches, and further afield, work together with guests to provide a week of sharing the good news of God's love for everyone, through enjoyable events, worship, and prayer, around Frinton and Walton, for children, youth, and adults. It all takes place in the beautiful surroundings of sea, beach, Greensward, and local churches and amenities.

Online volunteering closes on the 30th June. Two hundred volunteers are needed to help in the many varied roles: children's, adults', Love Frinton, Love Walton, Café, Day and/or hosting, information, and stewarding teams. **Please do pray** about how you could help and please do sign up.
