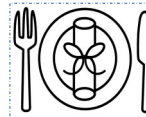
Community Friends is open to anyone of any age for friendship and fun over a good cup of coffee or tea - please have a word with Sue, Peter C or Ron P to find out more.

Our Daily Bread

Survey after survey have said that many more people own a copy of the Bible than read it. Everyone needs a little help when reading the Bible. Daily Bible reading guides have helpful notes on different Bible passages to help you understand what you're reading and relate it to modern-day issues and events. There are a few free copies of 'Our Daily Bread', a popular Bible notes series, covering July-September, available at the back of the church; a chance to 'try before you buy'.

SGP Bible Teaching Training Courses

Would you like to understand the Bible better and be equipped to help teach it to others?
