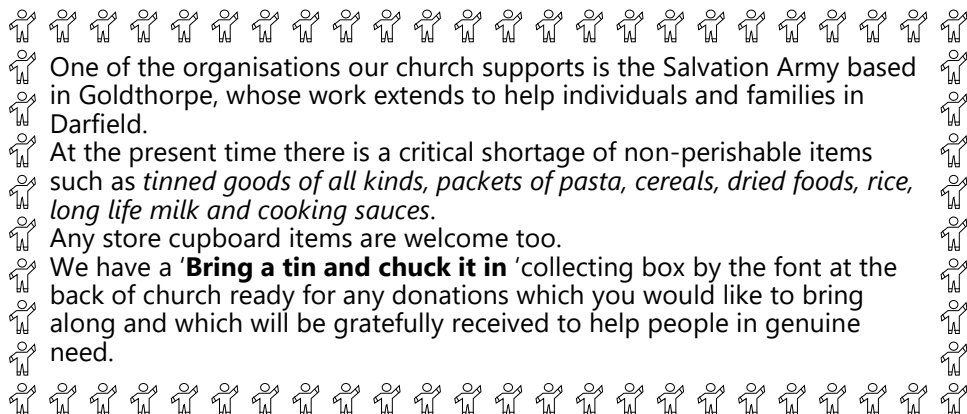

Put to the test [Genesis 22: 1-1]

Abraham's first-born son, Ishmael, had been sent away with his mother, Hagar. Isaac continued to grow and develop until a time when the LORD speaks again directly to Abraham. This time the command is to take Isaac to a mountain in the region of Moriah and sacrifice him there as a burnt offering to the LORD. Mount Moriah is identified as the site of King Solomon's Temple in Jerusalem. [2 Chronicles 3: 1]

Abraham did not hesitate. The following morning he loaded his donkey and took Isaac to the mountain along with two servants. As they neared the mountain the servants were left with the donkey. Isaac carried the wood while Abraham carried the knife and the fire for the burnt offering.

Isaac became concerned as they had no lamb for the sacrifice. Abraham told him that the Lord would provide the lamb. All was set up for the sacrifice and the knife raised when an Angel of the Lord spoke to Abraham telling him not to harm Isaac. Abraham had demonstrated that he feared God because he was prepared to sacrifice his only son even though Isaac at the time was the only way that God's promise of turning Abraham's descendants into a nation. As Abraham looked up, he saw a ram caught in a thicket and sacrificed it instead of Isaac. God's promise to Abraham is re-stated.

If we move forward many years after Abraham, we can follow the events which make the Israelite Nation and bring us to back to the region of Moriah where the events of Good Friday unfold in the shadow of the Temple. Another sacrifice of an only son but one who acted as a substitute for us as the Resurrection forms the basis of our faith.

Gracious Father, by the obedience of Jesus you brought salvation to our wayward world: draw us into harmony with your will, that we may find all things restored in him, our Saviour Jesus Christ.
