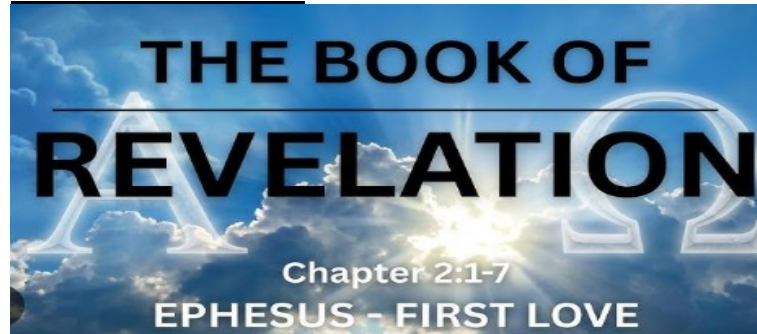

At last week's Crafty Chatty Church service, Anne spoke about prayer. Here is the style of prayer she spoke about based on the Lord's Prayer :-

Praise: Say thank you to God.

Purpose: Ask for His good plans to happen on earth.

Provision: Ask for what we need *just for today* (like food).

Pardon: Ask for forgiveness, and promise to forgive others.

Protection: Ask for help to make good choices.

Church Count on Nature



Churches across all denominations in England and Wales are participating in Churches Count on Nature (CCoN), an annual event where people visit churchyards supported by environmental charities A Rocha UK and Caring for God's Acre, as well as The Church of England. It takes place until this Sunday (14th June). If you would like to take part there are counting sheets available in church and in the hall and special resources for children which are available as a hard copy from next week or via the app. Last year, an estimated 6,000+ participants joined in. This helps to determine the distribution of species and can help churches increase the biodiversity on their land and manage their land well.
