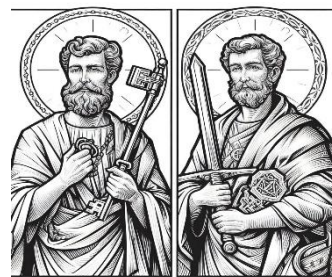
Next Week's Readings: Zechariah 9:9-12, Psalm 145, Romans 7: 15-25a, Matthew 11:16-19, 25-end
