SCRIPTURE READINGS

Genesis 18.1-15

Romans 5.1-8

Matthew 9.35-10.8

Reflection

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

In today's Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds and is moved with compassion. He sees people who are harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. His response is not judgment but mercy. He heals the sick, proclaims the good news of God's kingdom, and calls disciples to join in his work.



The compassion of Christ lies at the heart of this passage. Jesus does not turn away from human suffering. He sees people as they truly are, with

their fears, struggles, and hopes. His heart is stirred by their need.

The same Lord who looked upon the crowds in Galilee looks upon our world today. He sees loneliness, poverty, conflict, and spiritual hunger. He continues to respond with love and mercy. Jesus then tells his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few." God's work in the world is abundant, but it requires willing servants.

The disciples are sent out not because they are perfect or powerful, but because they have been called by Christ. They are entrusted with sharing God's love, healing, and hope.

This remains the calling of the Church today. Every Christian is invited to participate in Christ's mission. We may not all be preachers or missionaries, but each of us can bear witness to God's kingdom through kindness, generosity, prayer, and service. Wherever we are, we can reflect the compassion of Christ to those around us. Jesus instructs the disciples, "Freely you have received; freely give." Everything we have comes first from God—his grace, forgiveness, and love. Having received these gifts freely, we are called to share them freely with others. As we gather in worship today, may we hear Christ's call anew. May our hearts be moved by the needs of others.

May we pray for workers in God's harvest. And may we go out into the world as faithful disciples, sharing the good news of God's love in word and deed.

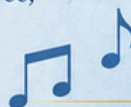
