- **PCC MEETING 1 JUNE 2026 PEWSHEET SUMMARY**

The PCC met on 1 June 2026. Subject to the approval of the minutes, the PCC discussed and agreed on the following. This is a summary of that meeting.

- **Policies**
- The PCC reviewed H&S, Lone Working and Children & Youth Groups policies.
- **Mission**
- There were several items and lots of discussion, including ideas for Prayer Walks and Eco-church. We then focused on:
- **Homegroups** – the hope is to have groups of 6-8 with options during the day or evening. These will include time for fellowship, prayer and bible study.
- **Fundraising/Vision Day** It was agreed that we need to keep fundraising distinct from giving. The PCC will consider giving at the next PCC meeting, which remains low. In July, we will focus on volunteering, which will feed into a vision day and a much-needed fundraising team. Fundraising needs to be fun and hospitable.
- **Messy church** – it is hoped we can do this on Saturday mornings from September, and it will be based in the church.
