Just Imagine...

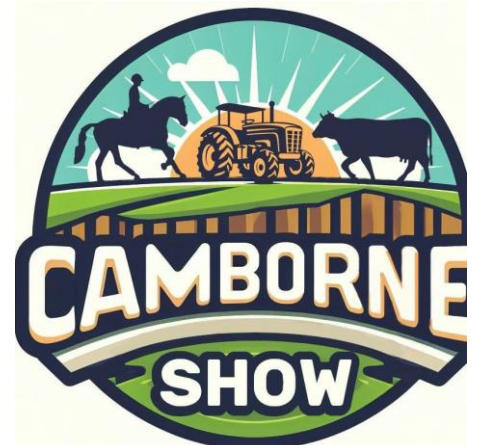
