## SUMMER SOLSTICE

On the longest day of the year, thousands of people make their way to Glastonbury Tor in Somerset to watch the sun rise. They climb in the dark, in community, and wait together for the light. It is one of the oldest human impulses there is - to mark the turning of the year, to pay attention to the natural world, to gather and say: this moment matters. The Tor itself holds a deeper story of shared ground: the ruined tower at its summit is the remains of a medieval Christian church, St Michael's, built on a hill that has drawn people of different beliefs for centuries. As the longest day is now behind us, it is worth pausing to reflect: "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge." Psalms 19:1-2. *From the Salisbury Diocese Board of Education*
