The service is family-friendly, and the stories are well worth listening to, so it's ideal to bring along neighbours, guests and friends.

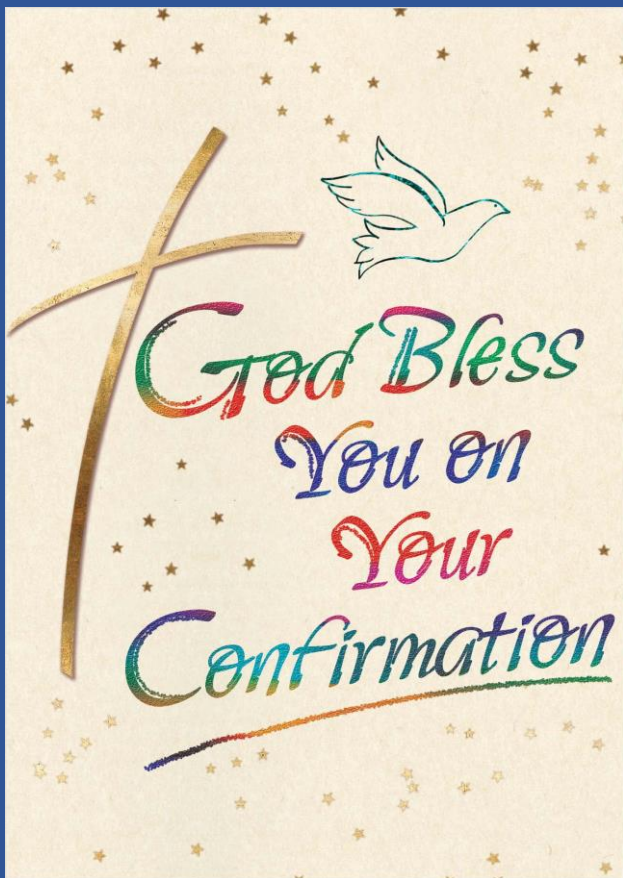
We will also be encouraging people to bring surfboards, wetsuits and body boards, in fact anything they use in the sea, and we'll bless them for the year ahead!

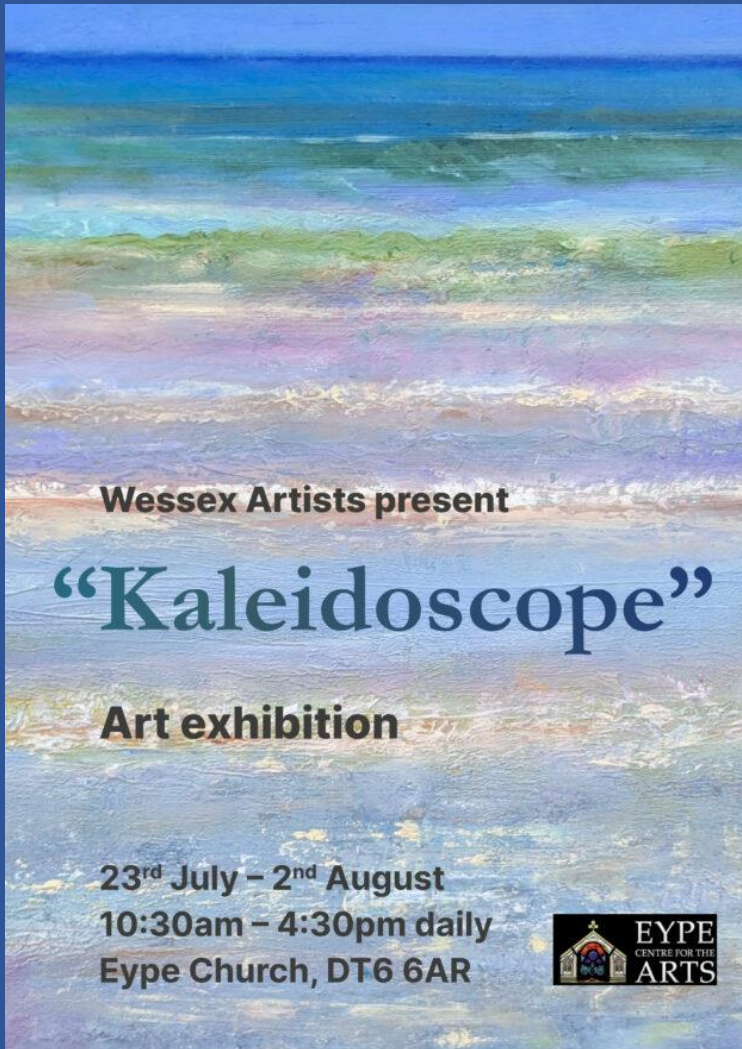

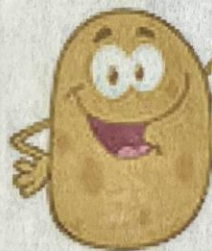
