## **NT: 2 Timothy 2:8-14 (GNT)**

<sup>8</sup> Remember Jesus, who was raised from death, as is taught in the gospel.

<sup>9</sup> Because I preach the Good News, I suffer and I am even chained like a criminal. But the word of God is not in chains, <sup>10</sup> and so I endure everything for the sake of God's chosen people, in order that they too may obtain the new life that comes through Jesus and brings eternal glory. <sup>11</sup> This is a true saying:

<sup>12</sup> If we continue to endure,  
we shall also rule with him.

If we deny him,  
he also will deny us.

<sup>13</sup> If we are not faithful,  
he remains faithful,  
because he cannot be false to himself.”

<sup>14</sup> Remind your people of this, and give them a solemn warning not to fight over words. It does no good, but only ruins the people who listen.

## **GOSPEL: Matthew 11:25 – end (GNT)**

<sup>25</sup> At that time Jesus said, “Father, Lord of heaven and earth! I thank you because you have shown to those without education what you have hidden from the wise. <sup>26</sup> This was how you were pleased to have it happen.

<sup>27</sup> “My Father has given me all things. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

<sup>28</sup> “Come to me, all of you who are tired from carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke and put it on you, and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit; and you will find rest. <sup>30</sup> For the yoke I will give you is easy, and the load I will put on you is light.”
