Zechariah 9:9-12 Psalm 145:8-15	Romans 7:15-25a	Matthew 11:16-19,25-end
Zechariah's prophecy anticipates the coming of Christ, whose humble, all-encompassing rule will bring peace to warring nations and freedom and restoration to God's oppressed people.	Paul laments that his desire to obey God's laws is continually sabotaged by forces within that drive sinful behaviour. Only God's power through Christ can bring release.	Jesus notes how this generation resists those whom God has sent. He invites those who are humble and needy to receive from him as he reveals God's kingdom.

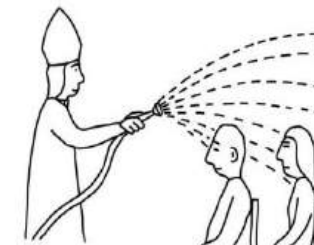

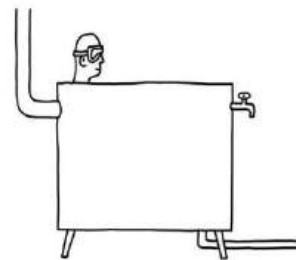

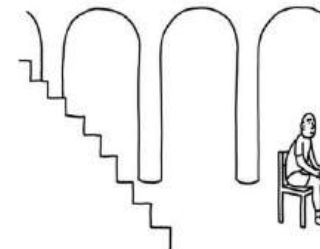

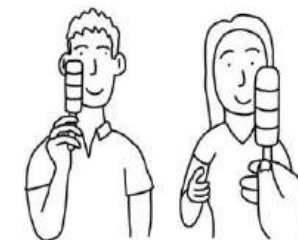
