Today's psalm offers instruction and comfort. In our world at the moment some of the loudest voices are ones where Christianity has been manipulated into something that does not demonstrate love. We see this in the rise of Christian Nationalism, where the love of the stranger is replaced by hate, where Jesus' radical equality is replaced by rejection. We must resist this, we must resist hate wherever we see it. We can choose to walk in God's truth. A truth that through the Holy Spirit teaches us love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Which we deepen through communion, prayer, reading the Bible, and in setting time aside each day as and when we can. Perhaps it is as we commute, or travel, as we prepare food, or the moment before we close our eyes to sleep, God is with us, and his compassion is available to us always.

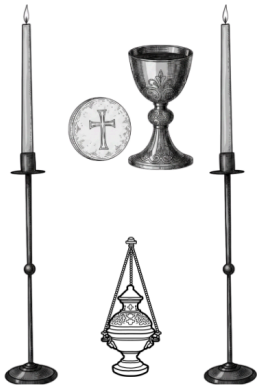
