All meals are provided - and they are good! - and there is a varied programme during the weekend, although there is never any pressure to join in anything. The cost per person for the weekend will be £182.50, with reductions for children, students, a carer accompanying someone and for single parents. There are very few ensuite rooms and there is a small additional charge for those. I am not sure at this stage whether there may need to be a small charge for transport but we will work that out nearer the time.

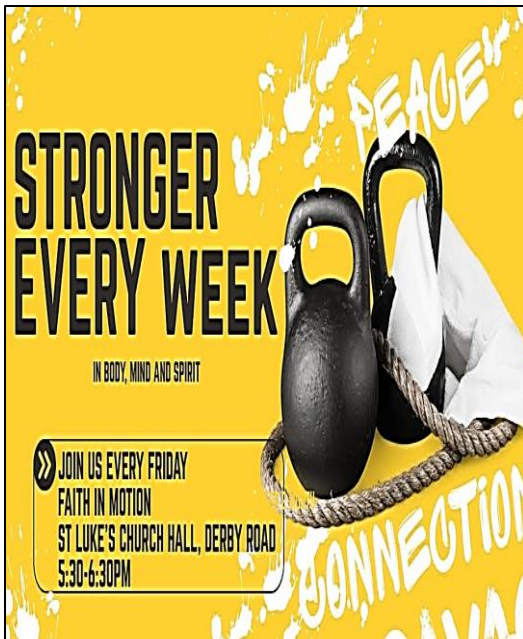
Please would you put your name on the list at the table at the back of church if you would be interested to come - and do speak to me or Christine or anyone else who came last time if you would like to know more.
