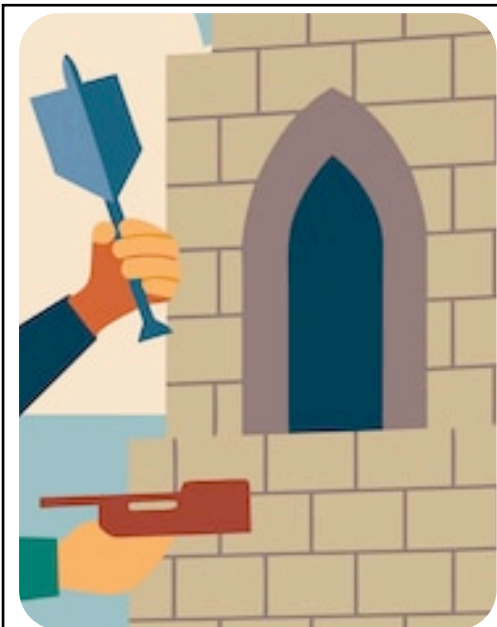
TEDDY BEARS' PICNIC
