July 15th is St Swithun's Day. Tradition says that if it rains on St Swithun's Day it will rain for 40 days and 40 nights. The weather forecast suggests that this will not be a problem this year! Tradition also says that if it is fine, then it will be fine for 40 days and 40 nights. Meteorologists tell us that there is some truth in this prediction. Wherever the jet stream is in the middle of July, it tends to stay there until the end of August and the weather will not change. St Swithun lived in the 9th century and was Bishop of Winchester. He was known for his piety and zeal for founding churches. He was a humble man who refused many of the trappings of his office. He always walked everywhere and, when he gave a banquet, he invited the poor not the rich. The king, Aethelwulf of Wessex, was so impressed by Swithun that, when asked by the bishop, he gave a 10th of his land to the church.

When Swithun died, he asked to be buried outside the church, where passers-by would walk and rain would fall on him. But following the restoration of the cathedral, it was dedicated to St Swithun and his body was transferred inside the church. On the day this was done there was torrential rain which continued for weeks. This was taken as a sign of the saint showing his displeasure. And so the legend began.

If this prediction proves true this year and our current weather continues, we pray for all farmers and growers in need of rain and for all who struggle in the heat.
