Let your peace rest gently upon them.

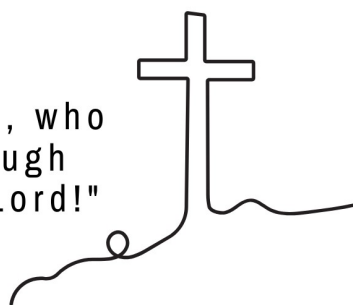
