RECEIVING COMMUNION

Bishop Robert has asked all clergy to inform their congregations that **he does not approve of the practice of intinction** (dipping the wafer in the wine at communion). In order to comply with the Bishop's wishes, please refrain from dipping the bread into the cup at communion. It is Anglican practice to share the common cup. If you prefer to receive only the bread, then our theology is that in doing so you receive both bread and wine in the one element.
