About Me

I'm a registered nurse who qualified in 1994 with the Portsmouth School of Nursing. I've worked in many hospitals and different areas of nursing since then, specialising in respiratory nursing, emergency care and ophthalmology.

As your parish nurse, I'll be able to help you find your way through health challenges, finding direction and navigating the difficulties of finding the help that's right for you. I'm also able to support you through bereavement and other troubling times.

What is parish nursing?

Parish nursing seeks to provide whole-person healthcare through a local church community. Based on Christ's teaching and ministry, Parish Nurses provide support for the physical, mental, social and spiritual health of individuals, and they are able to work with members of other faiths to achieve this. Parish Nurses are supported by a national charity, Parish Nursing Ministries UK.

All nurses are regulated by the Nursing and Midwifery Council and work under its code of practice. They work from their churches offering individuals and communities personal health advice, advocacy support and health education. They also offer support groups, train and support volunteers, and help people integrate their faith and their health.

Support from a Parish Nurse is available to people of all ages and from all faiths or none.
