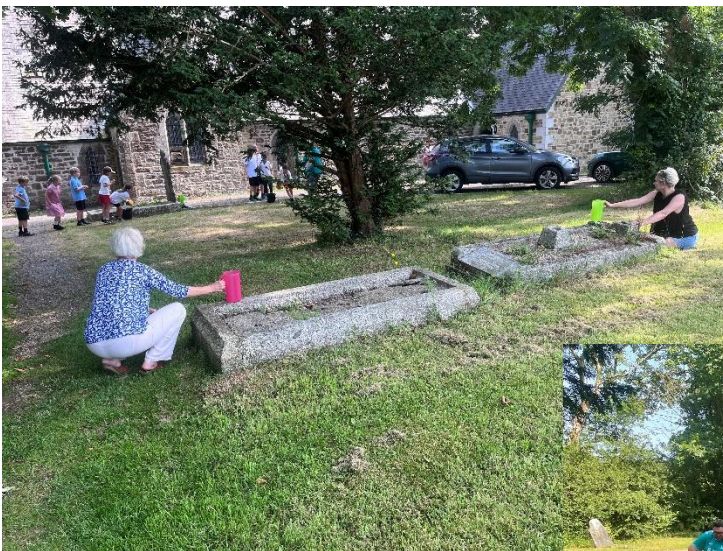


End of term party for Growing Church at Penponds
