Soon appearing at All Hallows Church in Woolsery will be a turquoise banner with the simple invitation: 'Try Praying' on it. You may have seen this on buses, at St. Mary's church Bideford or on other buildings. If you go online, the heading is followed by 'an invitation to experience the kindness of God'. A

booklet accompanies this which you can order for free and we have a quantity circulating following last week's coffee morning when 20 were handed out with the encouragement to read first oneself and then pass on to someone who comes to mind or you meet and God prompts you to offer. The booklet covers 7 days with a testimony from someone who has experienced God; followed by a prayer. The design is to help someone start praying who may have wanted to but hasn't been sure how to start. Of course, having passed it on, you will be able to check how the prayer is going! This recent initiative has been supported by the Methodists and I think we should follow it up across the Mission Community. Try it and see for yourself. Jane
