August Bank Holiday Weekend 28th - 31st August

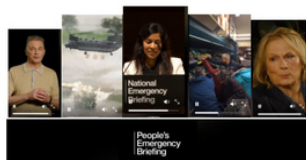
To raise funds for the Organ Restoration and Holy Trinity Flower Guild.
