

Wedding Fees for 2026

John Keble Church, Mill Hill

Publication of Banns of Marriage

Calling of banns (legal preliminary to marriage) £39.00

Certificate of Banns

Certificate of Banns after calling (not required if marriage is conducted at John Keble) £20.00

Marriage Service

Statutory Fee for Marriage Service (including minister and use of church) £566.00

Heating as required* £80.00

Organist Fee*† £150.00

Flowers* see note 5

Verger's Fee* £40.00

Illustrative total for Marriage Service (including publication of banns) £875.00

Notes

1. A certificate of banns only needs to be written where the couple are to be married in another parish. Fees for marriage by common licence are available on request. Please note that if one or both parties to the marriage are not UK nationals then it is unlikely that banns can be used as the legal preliminary (used for the illustrative costs on this page).

2. Items marked with an asterisk (*) are optional. Those marked with an obelisk (†) are subject to change depending on the availability and charges of a third party.

3. Heating is required in the church for weddings between October and the end of April.

4. As well as costs itemised here, couples should be aware that there may be additional copyright fees payable for the reproduction of some texts and where the service is being video recorded. These are generally payable to a third party and so not listed in the table of fees. Further details can be discussed during wedding preparation.

5. In addition to other costs, couples often request flowers in church for the wedding. Much depends on what you want for your wedding day. Please speak to our flower arrangers directly about this.

6. It's possible to get married in the Church of England if both parties live in the parish and are to be married by banns (but this is without e.g. music or heating) for only £605.00

7. Please note, that you will need to approach Barnet Council after the marriage in order to obtain your marriage certificate. Contact Registration Services for details.

Fees for future years are likely to include an inflation increment and are typically published in the Autumn.

9. The PCC expects a £100 deposit to be paid on booking the wedding with all fees to have been paid at the latest two weeks before the date of the ceremony. Payment should be made to John Keble Church PCC, sort code 20-29-37, account number 30497630. Please ensure that your surnames appear in the reference field (e.g. SMITH JONES).
