Eco Tip of the week

Keeping Cool in a Heatwave

Continuing along the Plastic Free July
theme - here are some sustainable tips to
follow during this warm weather:

1. Refill water bottles - An easy plastic to
cut out is plastic water bottles. It is im-
portant to stay hydrated, but instead of
buying new bottles, refill a bottle using a
local fountain. Find-a-Fountain, enables
you to locate a fountain (or tap) near you
with the aim to to increase the number of
free water sources across the nation.
2. Sustainable BBQs - We all love a bar-
becue when the sun comes out! Whether
in a park or in your back garden, try to re-
duce the plastic you use from food pack-
aging and look for reusable cutlery and
cup alternatives where possible. For fur-
