

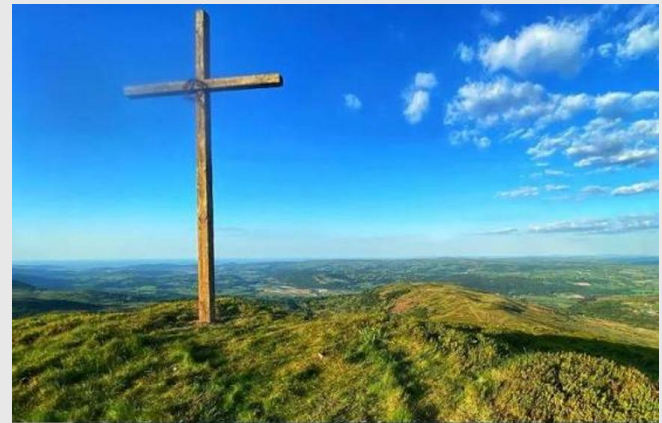

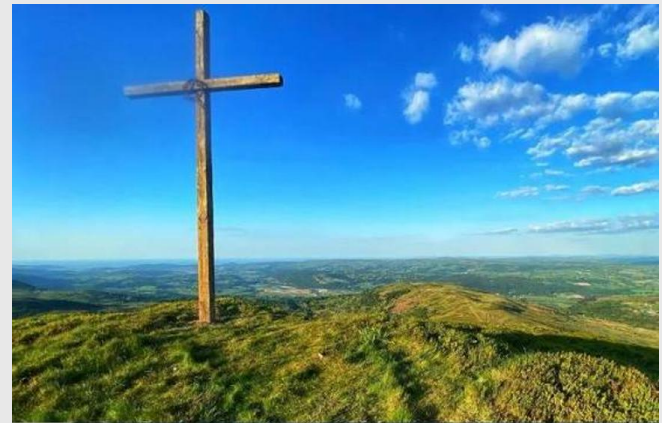
Hymn: In Christ Alone

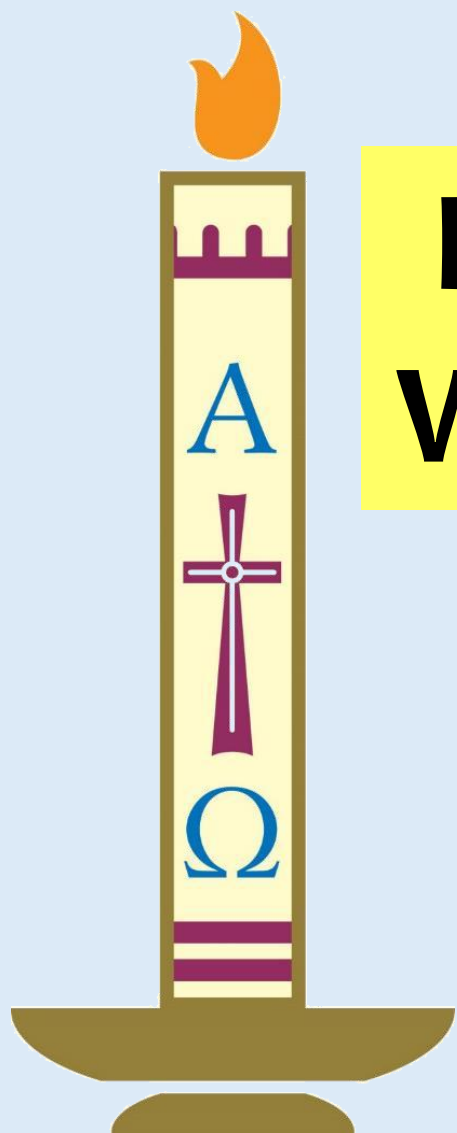

Baptism Welcome



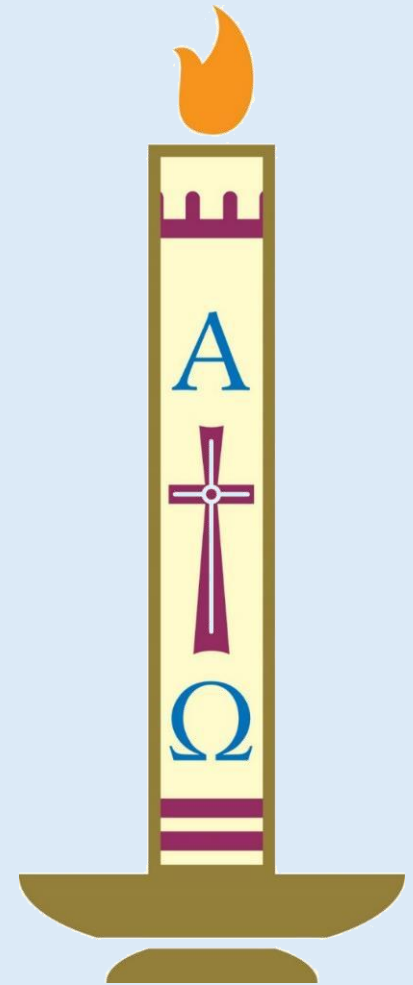
Baptism Welcome

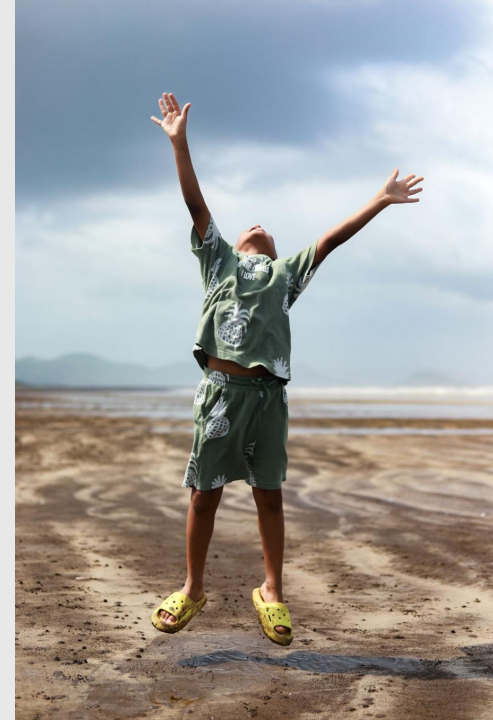

See the many crosses; symbols of God’s boundless love. Here there is enough to feed you all; and enough left over feed as many as are in need. Take a moment, in silence, to pray for our church partnership to thrive and to be a people who share Jesus with everyone they can.”

Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.

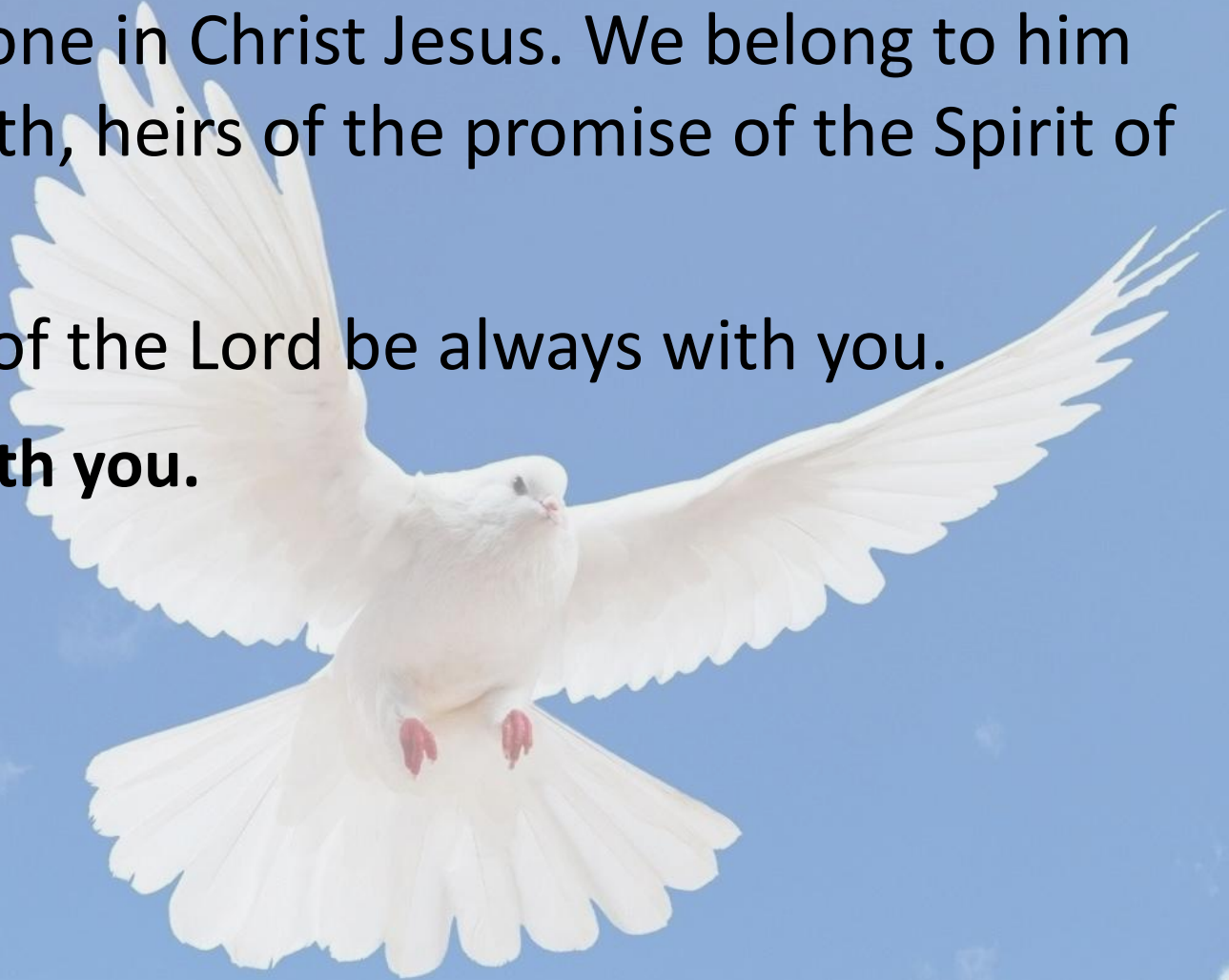
For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever. Amen
