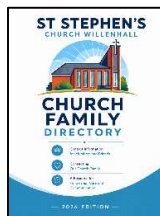


New Church Directory

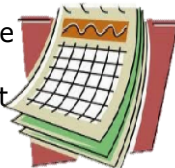


Activity Week 2026

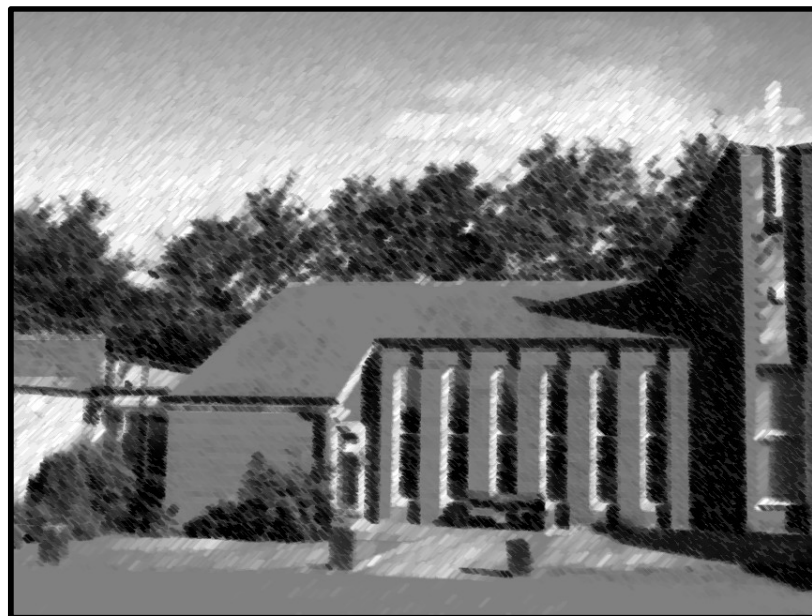
